CHC: WHERE IS IT NOW?

SOUTHEAST IMPLEMENTATION

- Implemented CHC in the southeast on January 1, 2019
- Approximately 127,000 Participants were transitioned to the CHC program
- Based on lessons learned during the Southwest implementation, DHS was able to prevent or mitigate many of the issues seen in the Southwest during the Southeast implementation.
- Lessons Learned (so far)
 - Earlier stakeholder engagement opportunities
 - Enhance communication materials and training regarding Medicare vs. CHC
 - More education and communication on continuity-of-care
 - MCO provider training and outreach to occur in the fall of 2019
 - Identify additional locations for participant information sessions
 - Schedule additional provider workshops in the fall of 2019



- Incorporation of southwest and southeast implementation and launch lessons learned








CHC PHASE 3 POPULATION




2019-20 BUDGET BY APPROPRIATION

2019-20 BUDGET REQUEST FACTORS

- Maintains FFS Programs in Non-CHC Zones
- Maintains Existing Service Levels for Participants
- Funds Implementation of CHC in the Lehigh/Capital, Northwest, and Northeast regions in January 2020
- Reflects Full-Year Operation of CHC in Southwest and Southeast
- Reflects Actuarial Sound Rates for CHC MCOs PH and LTSS
- Includes Continuation of the IGT Program for County NFs





MINIMUM WAGE UPDATE

2019-20 BUDGET PROPOSAL

- Budget proposal includes a minimum wage increase to \$12/hr.
- Average wage for direct care workers in OLTL programs is currently \$11.51/hr.
- Additional appropriations have been included in the budget to fund the minimum wage increase.
